### Galatians 1:1-11 (NLT)

- <sup>1</sup> This letter is from Paul, an apostle. I was not appointed by any group of people or any human authority, but by Jesus Christ himself and by God the Father, who raised Jesus from the dead.
- <sup>2</sup> All the brothers and sisters here join me in sending this letter to the churches of Galatia.
- <sup>3</sup> May God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace.
- <sup>4</sup> Jesus gave his life for our sins, just as God our Father planned, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live.
- <sup>5</sup> All glory to God forever and ever! Amen.
- <sup>6</sup> I am shocked that you are turning away so soon from God, who called you to himself through the loving mercy of Christ. You are following a different way that pretends to be the Good News
- <sup>7</sup> but is not the Good News at all. You are being fooled by those who deliberately twist the truth concerning Christ.
- <sup>8</sup> Let God's curse fall on anyone, including us or even an angel from heaven, who preaches a different kind of Good News than the one we preached to you.
- <sup>9</sup> I say again what we have said before: If anyone preaches any other Good News than the one you welcomed, let that person be cursed.
- <sup>10</sup> Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant.
- <sup>11</sup> Dear brothers and sisters, I want you to understand that the gospel message I preach is not based on mere human reasoning.

#### The true gospel vs. the twisted gospel.

- The true gospel is grace to us and glory to God.
- The twisted gospel is ritual from us and reward from God.

## Examples of twisted gospels:

- What we do (moralism)
- What we believe (intellectualism)
- What we feel (emotionalism/experientialism)
