Big Idea | The Kingdom of God forcefully advances, not by the *LOVE* of power, but by the *POWER* of love.

## Matthew 11:7-8 (NLT)

7 As John's disciples were leaving, Jesus began talking about him to the crowds. "What kind of man did you go into the wilderness to see? Was he a weak reed, swayed by every breath of wind? 8 Or were you expecting to see a man dressed in expensive clothes? No, people with expensive clothes live in palaces.

# Matthew 11:12 (NLT)

12 And from the time John the Baptist began preaching until now, the Kingdom of Heaven has been forcefully advancing, and violent people are attacking it.

## Philippians 3:19-20 (NLT)

## Philippians 3:12-14 (MSG)
