Ephesians 6:13-15 (NLT)

¹³ Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. ¹⁴ Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. ¹⁵ For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared.

Romans 8:37-39 (NLT)

- ³⁷ No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.
- ³⁸ And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. ³⁹ No

- 5. Why does trying to live righteously weigh us down? How does relying on God's strength (rather than your own) make a difference? Where in your life have you run into battle without your armor?
- 6. Read Romans 8:37-39. What does victory in spiritual battles look like in everyday life? Share a time when you saw God's victory in your own life.
- 7. If someone asked you why faith in Jesus matters, what would you say? Why are we far more uncomfortable sharing about our faith than anything else? How can we be

more intentional about sharing the peace of Christ with others?
