Big Idea: Raise God-seekers, not just good-doers.

GROUPS QUESTIONS:

1. How has your understanding of Proverbs 22:6 changed over time? Has there been a moment when you realized it was a principle, not a promise? How did that affect your parenting or expectations about parenting?
2. What does it mean to you to lead someone toward God, not just toward good behavior? Why do you think it's easier to focus on behavior over relationship when influencing others?
3. How do you personally balance teaching godly behavior with fostering a real relationship with Jesus in your home? What's

one small shift you've made (or could make) to point someone in your life more toward Jesus than just good behavior?

4. Share a moment when one of your kids or someone you know made a choice you couldn't control, and you had to release that guilt and trust God instead of blaming ourselves.
5. Have you ever seen someone come to faith despite a difficult or ungodly environment? What stood out to you about their story? What does that teach you about the power and grace of God?
6. How can we create "God-seeking environments" in our homes, friendships, or communities on a regular basis? What's one example of how you've seen faith modeled in an everyday setting?
7. What gives you hope when someone you care about seems distant from God? Share a time you saw God working in a way that reminded you He's ultimately in control.
